

ECHOES OF EMOTION: POETRY FROM THE HEART



The Stagecraft Studio: A New Beginning


Debuting this year, the English Club's Stagecraft Studio sparked creativity through drama, poetry, and speech—helping students build confidence, teamwork, and communication skills.

TRIGGERING TRIUMPH



A VISIT TO PATIALA DEAF AND DUMB SCHOOL




STRIDE & SEND-OFF: A DAY OF SPIRIT AND FAREWELL

ANNUAL SPORTS DAY




PAHALGAM ATTACK

"In the silence of Pahalgam's beauty, innocent lives were shattered." My heart aches for the innocent lives lost in the Pahalgam attack. I can only imagine the pain their loved ones are going through, and I share in their sorrow during this unimaginable time. The 2025 Pahalgam attack, which took place on 22 April in the Baisaran Valley of Jammu and Kashmir, claimed the lives of 26 civilians and left 20 injured. Five armed terrorists targeted mainly Hindu tourists and locals using weapons like AK-47s and M4 carbines. Among the victims was a newly married man who was shot in front of his wife, and a brave local Muslim who tried to snatch a gun from the terrorists and was killed. This brutal act escalated tensions between India and Pakistan, as India accused Pakistan of supporting terrorism—a pattern seen before in attacks like the 2008 Mumbai attack and the 2019 Pulwama attack. Pakistan denied involvement and referenced the Simla Agreement in response. In retaliation, India launched airstrikes on 7 May 2025 targeting terrorist camps, marking the beginning of Operation Sindoor—a mission symbolically named after the red powder worn by married women in India, reflecting strength, sacrifice, and remembrance. The operation was aimed at justice, not vengeance, with a clear focus on eliminating terrorist groups like Jaish-e-Mohammad and Lashkar-e-Taiba, without harming innocent Pakistani civilians. However, Pakistan accused India of attacking civilian areas and retaliated with airstrikes, leading to the first drone battle between the nations. India reported attacks on its air bases, including Sirsa, while Pakistan claimed strikes on bases like Nur Khan and Rafiqui under Operation Bunyan un Marsoos. The war lasted four intense days before both sides agreed to a ceasefire. I sincerely hope Pakistan chooses the path of peace and progress, leaving behind the shadow of violence and embracing a brighter future for all.
